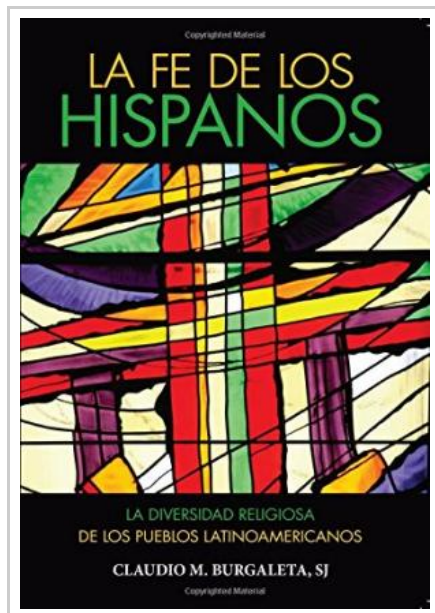




La Fe de los Hispanos: La Diversidad Religiosa de los Pueblos Latinoamericanos
